

The Objectives of the Queenstown Chaos:

- To ensure people get to experience the key suspects for being in Queenstown; Jet Boating and the Gondola

The Concept:

After an invigorating Jet Boat ride to start the afternoon, teams will return to central Queenstown where they will be on a mission to score as many points as possible completing activities, solving questions and following clues.

Jet Boating- A 60 minute experience with Kawarau Jet . Across the Lake, in the lower Shotover and on the Kawara River itself. An ideal wake up after lunch and before the race begins.

The Gondola and Luge- Each team will ride up the gondola and then selected team members must ride the luge while the rest can return in the gondola. Plus while up the top, there are other clues and information to discover.

Both of these activities will take up about two thirds of the experience, while the remaining time is made up of the following challenges;



Team Challenges- Teams will have to complete a problem solving activity or two on their trip gaining more points and further clues to their next challenge.

Scavenger Challenges – each team is given a list of items they must collect along the way. These may include an item from the local establishments and an item related to your company.

Local Knowledge Questions – each team must answer a range of questions relating to the local area.

Teams will be moving around by themselves and connecting with Rock and Ice guides at key locations to complete activities and receive their next clues. At the conclusion of the event, there will be a light-hearted prize giving ceremony for the winning team
