

An incredible day out experiencing the heart of Kiwi adventure in inland Canterbury on the South Island of New Zealand

The best thing about the Rakaia region (located an hours drive from Christchurch) and this programme, is that delegates have the option to chose which activity they would like to do based on their individual comfort zone and adrenaline levels.

At the beginning of the day, a presentation will show delegates what each activity has to offer. They will then be given a choice card where they can select their first choice, second choice, etc. and these will be entered into a database and the group split into activities based on their own preferences. From here, they will board buses to the Rakaia Gorge and be lead to their chosen activity.

JET BOAT RIDE AND RAFT BUILDING

Experience a 90km/hr jet boat blast through the gorge. Delegates will see fantastic views of the mountains and complete some 360 degree spins and high speed turns before arriving a short distance up the river. Here, the group will be split into teams and they must build a raft using the materials provided and float back to the starting point. Water balloons are encouraged!



COMPETITION MATCH ARCHERY AND CLAYBIRD SHOOTING

Rock & Ice will take participants through the finer points of archery providing tuition before teams step up to the targets to score points in a competition match. Archery is a fun activity that everyone can do. All you need to bring is a willingness to have a go, and a good eye!



Next to the archery event will be a claybird shooting set up. Each person will have a number of shots to see if they are up to hitting the clay pigeon as it flies past.

ADVENTURE ROPES COURSE

The ropes course provides both a fantastic team building exercise and a very real personal challenge. Individuals are challenged to step outside their comfort zones and tackle a real fear – the fear of heights. Featuring 5 low ropes and 7 high ropes initiatives including a 12 metre abseil, our course has something to offer for all abilities.



NATIVE BUSH WALK THROUGH WASHPEN FALLS

The group is taken on an easy walk through native bush to the waterfall. This is an easy stroll and accessible to all, and the round trip will take approximately an hour and a quarter. We then arrive at a remarkable shelter which has just recently been built. It sits beside a small pond in native forest, a bit like a 'lost world' – an absolutely stunning area that most people don't get to see.
